

#### **FOCUS 4: Survey of Attitudes of 16-19 Year Olds**

Student activities (in own school):

- A sample online survey for Focus 4 will be made available by the end of October 2009 and all participating schools will be issued with the details.
- The project leader in each school will contact the co-ordinating school before the end of November 2009 with any suggested improvements for, or additions to, the online survey. Students from each school should be involved in assessing the usefulness of the survey and in the testing of the sample survey.
- Final survey will go live on Monday 7 December. All participating schools will be issued with all the necessary details at this time.
- All participating schools will ensure that a minimum of 100 students aged between 16 years and 19 years will have completed the survey before it is closes on 1 February 2010.
- The entire survey results will be circulated to the teachers of all the participating schools before the visit to Denmark.
- The students in each school will be issued with the results for their own school when the survey closes on 1 February 2010. The students should familiarise themselves with the results for their own school in preparation for the activity in Denmark.

Student activities (Denmark):

Students will be placed in groups with two groups assigned to each of the four foci. The activity for Focus 4 will be:

Students from each country will present the survey findings for their country. Together they will agree how best to present the results of the whole survey and in what format. Results may be presented separately or collectively or both. The format of the outcome will be decided by the pupils and a copy of the final presentation will be put on the project website.
