- Profiles of all students, from each of the participating schools, to be forwarded to co-ordinating school (St. Patrick's College, Maghera, Northern Ireland) by 23rd October 2009.
- Co-ordinating school to publish all profiles on project website by 26th October 2009. Details of website will be issued to all participating schools on this date (26th October 2009).
- A sample online survey for Focus 4 will be made available by the end of October 2009 and all participating schools will be issued with the details.
- The project leader in each school will contact the co-ordinating school before the end of November 2009 with any suggested improvements for, or additions to, the online survey.
- Final survey will go live on Monday 7 December. All participating schools will be issued with all the necessary details at this time.
- All participating schools will ensure that a minimum of 100 students aged between 16 years and 19 years will have completed the survey before it closes on 1 February 2010.
- To ensure ongoing engagement between the students from each country, a bulletin board will be established. Three topics for discussion will be posted, one at a time, and all students will be expected to make a minimum of one contribution to each of the topics. The topics will be related to the project and students should be advised to read the contributions of others, before adding their own. The dates for the topics are as follows:
 - Topic 1 ~ This topic will be live from Monday 9 November 2009 until Monday 7 December 2009.
 - Topic 2 ~ This topic will be live from Monday 7 December 2009 until Monday 18 January 2010.
 - Topic 3 ~ This topic will be live from Monday 18 January 2010 until Monday 22 February 2010.
- Co-ordinating school will issue worksheets for the completion of the food diary activity, with guidelines, to all participating schools by 10 November 2009.
- Each student will have completed his or her food diary by mid-December.
- Meeting in Denmark ~ student workshops and presentations ~ 23rd – 28th March 2010
- During the meeting in Denmark participating teachers will hold a meeting to discuss brief outline arrangements for Year 2.
- Website to be updated by end of June 2010 which will herald the close of Year 1 of the HEY Comenius Project.
