

## **FOCUS 2: First Aid – Caring for the body in emergency situations**

### STUDENT ACTIVITIES (IN OWN SCHOOL)

- Each school should research good practice for “First Aid” in their own countries
- Students should ideally take part in a “First Aid” Course in their own schools
- Students should collect/prepare materials to illustrate best practice for specific “First Aid” situations
- Students should be prepared to demonstrate “First Aid” for at least 3 different scenarios/situations

### STUDENT ACTIVITIES (IN COLMAR)

#### **The key activities:**

**1 All students allocated to this group will meet and discuss/compare “First Aid” procedures within/between their respective countries noting any differences in techniques (if any)**

**2 The group will be subdivided into TWO subgroups. Each of these subgroups will select THREE different accident/incident scenarios and prepare to demonstrate “first aid” procedures. They will need to prepare an accompanying “Guide Sheet” which will demonstrate the best practice for each scenario. (NB if there are differences in procedures between the countries students will negotiate with each other and or seek guidance)**

**3 Each sub group will demonstrate first aid procedures for each of the scenarios. Following each demonstration the group will explain with the aid of the the “Guide Sheet” the principles behind their demonstration**
